**Enacted(1):** A section for subcommittees be added under III S.G.A.C. §001a.3(3)b: The creation of all subcommittees shall be presented to the Internal Affairs Committee by the chair that subcommittee falls under; and,

**Enacted (2):** The necessity of the subcommittee shall be approved by a majority vote of the Internal Affairs Committee; and,

**Enacted(3):** The chair the subcommittee falls under must select a subcommittee chair and has five minutes to present them to the senate body explaining the purpose of the subcommittee as well as reasons the specific subcommittee chair was chosen; and,

**Enacted(4):** The subcommittee chair will need to be confirmed by a two-thirds vote of the senate body; and,
