**Whereas(2):** The formal amendment process is currently the only acceptable way to edit simple written errors in legislation; and,

**Whereas(3):** Using the formal amendment process for simple revisions is an inefficient and lengthy application of such parliamentary procedure.

**Enacted(1):** With the consent of the present legislative author(s) and being deemed appropriate by both the Speaker of the Senate and the Rules and Regulations Chair a formatting, grammatical, capitalization, punctuation, or spelling error may be corrected without a formal amendment; and,

**Enacted (2):** Appropriate titles of those who introduce or sponsor legislation or a copy of the legislation is sent to may be amended, under the same criteria outlined above, if proven to be incorrect; and,

**Enacted(3):** If a written error is noticed after the passage of a piece of legislation, it may be corrected if the Speaker of the Senate and Rules and Regulations Chair are in agreement of such revision and the bill author(s) are made aware of the error(s) and revision(s); and,
