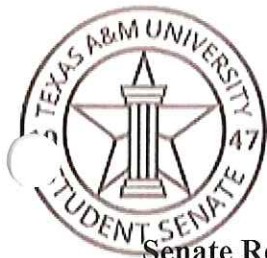

*"A resolution which encourages Texas A&M students to register to vote, update their voter registration, and vote in the 2018 Midterm elections"*
