Constituency Affairs Absence Reform Act

"A act to update absence make-ups in accordance to The Code and the Committee of Constituency Affairs"

Whereas(1): With limiting the tabling hour sessions to during election cycles causing fewer opportunities for Senators to excuse their absences; and,

Whereas(2): There is a need for Senators to have more opportunities to excuse their absences and avoid absencing out.

Enacted(1): Let the following be added to III S.G.A.C. §001.4(6)(a)(3). "Senators may excuse one unexcused absence for meeting with a *confirmed non-voting delegate* in the Committee of Constituency Affairs or an executive from an approved student organization that is partnered with a caucus recognized by Student Activities; and,
