



## MSC Sanitizer Bill

*"A bill to place hand sanitizer stations in the main MSC dining hall"*

**Whereas(1):** Currently there are no hand sanitizer stations in the main MSC dining hall; and,

**Whereas(2):** Most of the food offered at the dining hall are finger foods; and,

**Whereas(3):** Sanitation is a priority for food service in general. However students do not currently have the option to clean their hands before consuming food provided by the MSC.

**Whereas(4):** This vulnerability of the university's health and safety standards could be detrimental and potentially hazardous to student well-being.
