The Legislation Improvement Act *Special Designation: An Act of the Senate*

"An act ensuring consistency and professionalism of legislation passed by the Student Senate."

Whereas(1): There have been many ill-formatted, badly worded and grammatically incorrect pieces of legislation being introduced to and passed within the Senate in this and in past sessions; and,

Whereas(2): This can hurt the professional image of the Senate and continuity of the Senate's message as seen by outside parties through the legislation that is passed and sent out.

**Therefore
Let it be**

Enacted(1): That III S.G.A.C §001a, Article VI, Section V, subsection (j) be added and read as follows:

(j) Before a final vote or consideration of Consent Agenda can occur on any piece of legislation, said legislation shall conform to the currently approved legislative template; this legislative template can be proposed by any member of the Internal Affairs Committee, shall be approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Internal Affairs Committee and shall be made easily available in an online format to all members of the Senate, or anyone upon request.
