The Student Services Transportation Bill

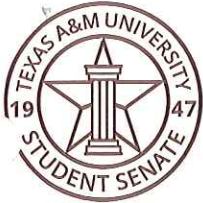
"A bill advocating for optimization of transportation services and options in regards to the White Creek temporary Student Services facilities."

Whereas(1): There are logistical concerns regarding transportation infrastructure around the temporary Student Services facilities located in the White Creek region of campus; and,

Whereas(2): Ability to access these services is imperative to their use by students; and,

Whereas(3): Specific concerns reside in Student Counseling Services and Disability Services, where ease of access is especially important; and,

Whereas(4): Students have specifically expressed frustration with transportation to and from the White Creek facilities, citing up to 45 minute one-way commutes and lack of adequate daytime parking; and,

Whereas(5): While temporary, 30 minute parking is provided near the facilities, the quantity of such options is limited and does not adequately meet the time commitment of many of the services provided, including appointments and disability services testing.

Therefore

Let it be

Enacted(1): Transportation Services should coordinate with Disabilities and Student Counseling Services to provide confidential, free, and temporary parking vouchers in Lots 122A, 122B, 112, 114, 119, and 107 for students utilizing their services with a documented appointment; and,

Enacted (2): In the event that a student utilizes the White Creek Services without a proper voucher or permit, for example in the use of emergency services, and receives a citation from Transportation Services, proof of service use will be accepted by Transportation Services as an authorized waiver of the citation costs; and,
