Whereas(3): With the option of a sanitary door opener, students less likely to use a paper towel or toilet paper, which in turn decreases waste and overconsumption; and,

Whereas(4): The installation of sanitary door openers allows the university to save money on annual paper towel spending for Evans library; and,

Whereas(5): Having sanitary door openers available at Evans will allow for the decrease in the spread of the common cold and other contagious diseases that affect students throughout the course of the year, and an increase in overall cleanliness during heavy traffic periods.

Enacted(1): That Evans Library will install 18 sanitary door openers for the 18 total bathrooms in the entire facility; and,
