"A bill updating when the collection of money occurs."

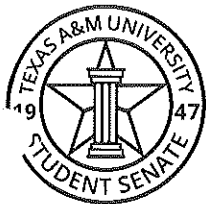
Whereas(1): The current selection of collectee does not coincide with the period for collection; and,

(b) The Student Body President shall determine his designee for the collection of


