Enacted(1): That V S.G.A.C. §104.2.1 (c.1.i) be amended to read:

(i) All executive branch committees that are not open to all students must submit a copy of their by-laws delineating their processes for admissions yearly to the Senate Archives and Cabinet position in charge of Committees. These by-laws must also be available on their website. The Judicial Court shall consider how these processes were followed and the Constitutionality of these
