"A resolution to urge and request all Texas A&M University students, faculty, and staff to register to vote by October 11th, 2016."

Whereas(1): Texas A&M University is striving to get more students, faculty, and staff involved in the democratic process and exercise their civic duty; and,

Whereas(2): With the creation of Gig The Vote, a nonpartisan SGA initiative aimed to increase Aggies' voting participation in Brazos County, our student leaders should contribute to the voter registration movement by supporting the initiative; and,

Whereas(3): In 2014, 58% of all college aged students were not registered to vote; and,

Whereas(4): Voting is the right and obligation of all eligible citizens, and only 41% of eligible college aged voters participated in the 2012 elections; and,

Whereas(5): A unified student, faculty, and staff commitment by Texas A&M University to vote could result in a commitment of the Texas state legislature to Texas students; and,

Whereas(6): This election cycle will decide the direction of the United States of America for years to come, and young people aged 18-29 constitute for nearly a quarter of the electorate; and,

Whereas(7): In 2015, only 19% of students at Texas A&M University were registered to vote in Brazos County; and,

Whereas(8): By increasing voter turnout both at Texas A&M University and in the Brazos County area, we can contribute as a unified campus to Gig the Vote.
