

Whereas(2): Pedestrian and motorist safety is an ongoing challenge in our growing city due to population growth and current infrastructure; and,


Whereas(3): One of our own fellow students, Caroline Killian '18, passed away from a three vehicle collision on 2818 and Holleman Drive; and,

Let it be

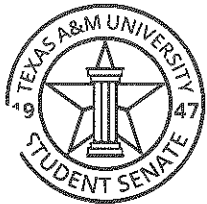


