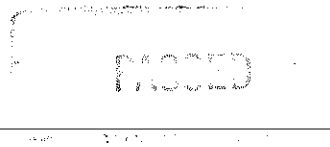



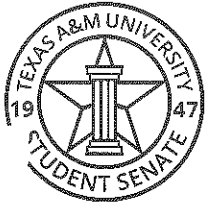

- Whereas(6):** Students from across Texas A&M University should unite in the effort to support those affected by Hurricane Harvey by getting involved with BTHO Harvey's network.


