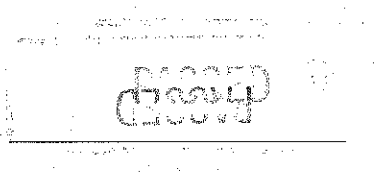



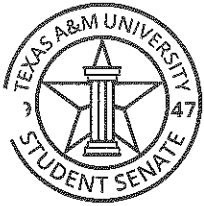

## Texas Tough Together Resolution

*"A resolution recognizing the efforts of the Texas Tough Together: Hurricane Harvey Relief Fundraiser"*

- Whereas(1):** As we are all aware, Hurricane Harvey ravaged Texas, by first making landfall on the evening of August 25th near Rockport, Texas as a Category 4 hurricane; and,
- Whereas(2):** Hurricane Harvey later stalled over south Texas on August and slowly meandered through the region, dumping close to 27 trillion gallons of water in a 5-day stretch over Texas and Louisiana; and,


