

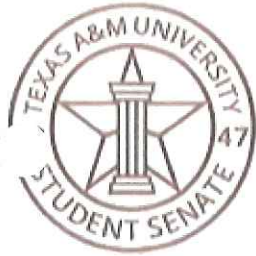
## University Contract Renegotiation Resolution

*"A resolution to encourage the university to renegotiate Chartwells' Contract"*

**Whereas(1):** Texas A&M outsourced services to Compass Group USA, which uses a subsidiary, Chartwells to handle on campus dining; and,

**Whereas(2):** On-Campus Freshman are currently required to purchase a dining plan for both their fall and spring semesters of their first year; and,

**Whereas(3):** Students cannot currently retain unused meals from semester to semester; and,




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**Whereas(4):** Without meal trade rollovers it is difficult for students to fully utilize the services they paid for; and,

**Whereas(5):** The maximum number of meal swipes allowed per day is four; and,

**Whereas(6):** Despite the diverse dining options, each facility has different hours of operation and are a far walking distance from each other, which limits the number of dining options a student has at any given time; and,

**Whereas(7):** This, in turn, creates long lines at the facilities, which severely cuts into students' time of recreation and study.

**Resolved(1):** In conjunction with the student body, the Texas A&M University Student Government Association stands in support of a contract revision with Chartwells; and,

**Resolved(2):** A contract revision occur that allows students to keep the meal trades that they have purchased through the end of each semester by enacting meal trade rollovers; and,
