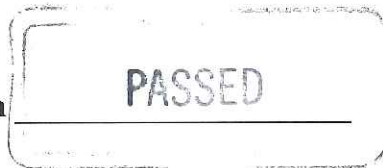

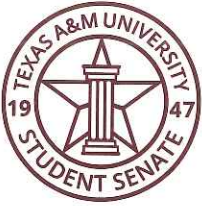

The Aggie Recovery Community Advocacy Resolution

"A resolution advocating for University support of The Aggie Recovery Community"

- Whereas(1):** There are many demonstrable cases within the Aggie community of addiction and misuse, be it with regards to illegal or prescription drugs, nicotine products, alcohol, activities or materials of a sexual nature, eating disorders or other causes; and,
- Whereas(2):** The Aggie Recovery Community (ARC) offers services and assistance to students suffering from addiction, with the eventual goal of rehabilitation and recovery; and,
- Whereas(3):** ARC currently receives very limited support from the University, in contrast to the University funding resource centers such as the GLBT, Disability, and Multicultural resource centers; and,
- Whereas(4):** Other Tier 1 research institutions in the state of Texas, including t.u. and Rice, and other Texas universities, including Texas Tech, Baylor, and UNT, already provide support for students struggling with addiction; and,
