Whereas(1): The SGA committee "Aggie Replant" seeks to adhere to its mission while

Whereas(2): After the Bastrop forest fires in September 2011, Replant initiated the "Bastrop

Line Pines Recovery" program; and,

Whereas(3): Relief efforts made outside of the Bryan/College Station area are not under the

purview of the current mission statement; and,

Whereas(4): Modifying the mission statement would help Replant create a constitutional

consistency in their mission, values, and projects.

Therefore Let it be

Enacted(1):

That III S.G.A.C. §001.4(13) shall be edited to read:

(a) STATUTORY ESTABLISHMENT. There is established an executive branch committee known as "Replant."

(b) Mission Statement

(1) "The Replant Committee exists to organize and operate Replant Day, a one-day environmental service project which strives to improve the Bryan/College Station community, to bring students together through tradition, and to provide an avenue for environmental service and action through a yearly tree planting event."

"Aggie Replant is an environmental service organization which strives to improve its greater community and bring students together through tradition, unity and selfless service by providing an avenue for environmental service through annual tree planting events, such as Replant Day."

(c) Primary Charge

(1) A primary charge of the Replant Committee shall be to organize and operate all activities, programs, and service projects related to Replant Day. The utilization of student fees shall be constrained to the primary charge and shall be limited to Brazos County; and,
