The Career Closet Establishment Act
Special Designation – An Act of the Senate

“A bill establishing the Career Closet—a committee charged with ‘Collaborating with the Texas A&M Career Center to enhance the professionalism of Texas A&M students while alleviating the financial burden associated with interviewing for a job’”

Whereas(1): While Texas A&M provides a world-class education to students and prepares them for the work force, some students cannot afford professional attire; and,

Whereas(2): The Texas A&M University Student Government Association exists “in order to provide an officially recognized student organization that identifies and represents student interests, promotes student participation in the overall policy and decision-making processes of the University, enhances the quality and scope of education at the University, and promotes the general welfare of the student body”; and,

Whereas(3): III S.G.A.C. §002.1 (5)(a) states:

A Committee or a Commission is defined as an organization in which the primary mission is to perform services that are of direct immediate benefit to the student body and to the community of Texas A&M University; and,

Whereas(4): The Career Closet embraces the mission of the Texas A&M Student Government Association, is of immediate benefit to the student body, and strongly embraces the Aggie Core Value of Selfless Service.

Therefore

Let it be

Enacted(1): That V S.G.A.C. §104.4 (16) shall now read:

SECTION VIII. Career Closet

- (a) STATUTORY ESTABLISHMENT. There is established an executive branch committee known as the “Career Closet.”
- (b) Mission Statement
 - (1) The Career Closet’s mission is collaborating with the Texas A&M Career Center to enhance the professionalism of Texas A&M students while alleviating the financial burden associated with interviewing for a job.
- (c) Primary Charge
 - (1) The primary charge of the Career Closet shall be to provide professional attire to students for job interviews, career fairs, and any other professional events required to enter into the workforce.
