Campus Sidewalk Bill

"A bill requesting additional sidewalks to be installed: near the front entrance of the Horticulture building, between Lewis Street and Lot 40D"

Whereas(1): Many students in Mays Business School park in Lot 74 and the surrounding lots; and,

Whereas(2): Many Cadets park in Lot 40D and walk through the grass between Lewis St. and Lot 40D; and,

Whereas(3): The current sidewalks between Lot 74 and Wehner, in front of the Horticulture Building, are rounded with no direct path to and from the main entrance of Wehner; and,

Whereas(4): There is no sidewalk between Lewis St. and Lot 40D; and,

Whereas(5): Students have taken it upon themselves to create their own pathways through the grass in these areas; and,
