*"A bill requesting that the city of College Station takes steps to protect our Ags in the northgate entertainment district."*

**Whereas(1):** The Northgate District is located on one of the busiest streets of College Station: University Drive; and,

**Whereas(2):** The concrete barrier on Northgate only extends from the Dry Bean Saloon to Basil Whippets Pub; and,

**Whereas(2):** The safety of the residents of College Station should be of utmost importance to the city; and,

**Whereas(3):** A concrete barrier across the Northgate District could greatly diminish jay-walking, as well as students falling into on-coming traffic, thus protecting the well-being of those on foot and those driving.
