**The CARPOOL Appropriations Act Repeal Act**  
*"A bill repealing S.B. 67-81, The CARPOOL Act."*

**Whereas(1):** The Texas A&M University Student Government Association is the official voice of the student body; and,

**Whereas(2):** Texas A&M University Student Senate should allocate funds each year on an as-needed basis, and any absolute requirement of a particular amount of funds to be allocated to any one committee sets a dangerous precedent for the allocations process; and,

**Whereas(3):** The original S.B. 67-81 bill as passed is absent from the archives and has not been added to the S.G.A.C.; and,
