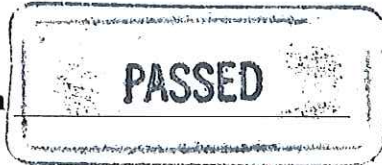

### City of College Station Uber Regulation Support Resolution

*"A resolution expressing the students' support for the City of College Station's regulation of Uber."*

- Whereas(1):** Uber provides rides to people in the College Station area; and,
- Whereas(2):** Many students do not have vehicles and benefit enormously from affordable travel options to tutoring and extracurricular activities; and,
- Whereas(3):** Whether or not a student uses Uber, alternatives such as taxis or Carpool will be more available or cheaper if Uber operates in the area; and,
- Whereas(4):** The City Council of College Station is considering regulations which are designed to increase the safety of Uber users; and,
- Whereas(5):** City of College Station staff have worked diligently to incorporate the opinions of Uber, taxi service providers, and the Texas A&M student body; and
