Whereas(5): Buildings whose architecture does not go out of style over time, such as the Academic Building, the Administration Building, The YMCA Building, etc. provide a more aesthetically appealing campus atmosphere which is expected of a top tier university;

Buildings such as Zachery, Blocker, Heldenfels, etc. detract from the aesthetic culture of

our historic and traditional campus.

Enacted(1):

The Texas A&M Student Government Association, on behalf of the students of Texas A&M University, recommend that the administration of Texas A&M model the future design of new buildings as well as future construction and renovations on campus to be consistent with traditional architecture (i.e. YMCA Building, Academic Building, Jack K. Williams Administration Building, Sbisa Dining Hall, etc.); and,
