The Might I Discern The Earned Ratio of My (MIDTERM) Grade Bill

"A bill to provide midterm grades to all students."

- Whereas (1): The Texas A&M Student Senate has a duty and obligation to serve students, and protect their academic pursuits; and,
- Whereas (2): Currently, only students with 30 or less hours are obligated to receive a midterm update on their grades; and,
- Whereas (3): Knowing the current grade in a course midway through a semester can be helpful to students' decisions regarding their academic intentions in a given course; and,
- Whereas (4): All students deserve the opportunity to review their performance in a given course, and to be well informed of said performance.

Therefore

Let it be

Enacted (1): That the Texas A&M University Student Senate calls for the release of midterm grades to all enrolled students at Texas A&M University, in the same way that students with 30 or less hours receive midterm grades; and,

Enacted (2):

That midterm grades be released to all enrolled students in a manner to be determined by the professor of the given class, providing that said grades are released in a fair and timely manner; and,

Enacted (3):

That midterm grades be released no later than ten (10) days before the Q-drop date; and,

Let it be

Enacted (4):

That if no grades have been assessed in a given course midway through the term, then no midterm grade release shall be required; and,
