

The Gatorade Bill

"A bill requesting for all dining facilities to include more non-carbonated drinks in the fountain dispensers."

Whereas(1): Many Texas A&M students have meal plans to eat regularly on campus, but are concerned about making healthy eating decisions and,

Whereas(2): Currently, most fountain dispensers in on-campus dining facilities have few non-carbonated drink options, leaving students to drink more sugary and unhealthy beverages and,

Whereas(3): Texas A&M Dining is now managed and controlled by Chartwells, so any requests for changes in dining options must be communicated to them
