The West Campus Libraries Improvement Bill

"A bill requesting financial assistance for the enlargement of the West Campus Library and expansion of library facilities on West Campus."

Whereas(1): Student usage of West Campus Library has grown to full capacity during the fall of

2013; and,

Whereas(2): A growing student population based on incoming freshmen and retention has

created more students needs in terms of desired study and computer lab space; and,

Whereas(3): Multiple students and the Office of the Dean of Libraries have come forward with

concerns about the need for more library services on West Campus; and,

Whereas(4): The proposal for new dorms on West Campus allows for 4000 student to begin

living on campus as phases for the construction of the dorms are to be completed;

Whereas(5): The first phase of construction for the new West Campus dorms is set to begin in

spring 2014; and,

layout of the new living and learning community that will be constructed on West

Campus with the building of the new dorms; and,

That the Student Government Association requests a search for donors for these

improvements begin immediately and on a scale that would keep student fees from

being raised to cover the cost of construction; and,
