The 59 Hours Bill

"An act allowing students to register for courses if they are on the verge of a necessary classification."

Whereas(1): Many courses offered at Texas A&M are restricted to upper classmen; and,

Whereas(2): Not every major will allow a student to be forced into a class and the class may fill in the time that it takes to get approval to enter the class; and,

Whereas(3): The nature of a modern college education evokes situations where the cookiecutter four years/15 hours a semester plan may not fit every student. This includes many students from the ones who had taken college credit classes in highschool to the students whose schedules do not allow for a full course load; and,

Therefore Let it be

Enacted(1): That Texas A&M Students shall be allowed to register for classes with classification restrictions, provided that they would have a sufficient number of hours upon the
