The Maroon and Orange Act Special Designation: Act of the Senate

"An Act to establish the ability to lobby for a renewed A&M vs. t.u. rivalry."

Whereas(1): Texas A&M and University and t.u. rivalry has been discontinued indefinitely; and,

Whereas(2): Many state rivalries such as Auburn versus Alabama, Georgia versus Georgia Tech, and Clemson versus South Carolina are mandated by state legislation; and,

Whereas(3): Texas A&M and t.u. rivalry was strong for 96 years straight; and,

Whereas(4): These rivalry games bring valuable income and attention to the universities, the state economy, and the state of Texas as a whole.

Texas A&M shall send representatives to the state legislature to lobby for this petition;

These delegates shall be appointed by a conference of the Legislative Affairs Chair,

The Vice President of Legislative Relations, and the Speaker of the Student Senate; and,

Enacted(3):

These appointees shall be approved by a two-thirds Senate confirmation; and,

Enacted(4):

These delegates shall immediately be removed if matters outside of Student

Senate-approved lobbying topics are discussed; and,
