The Jones Street Safety Bill

"A bill asking for the relocation of the Jones Street dumpster."

- Whereas(1):** Jones Street is a major thoroughfare for vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians; and,
- Whereas(2):** A portion of the sidewalk near the FHK Complex is interrupted by a dumpster surrounded by a brick housing extending to the Jones Street curb; and,
- Whereas(3):** This often causes pedestrians to step into the oncoming bike lane, exposing them to the dangers associated with pedestrian interference in a high traffic area; and,
- Whereas(4):** When the dumpster is exchanged, the westbound bike lane and part of the road is blocked, forcing all westbound traffic into the eastbound bike lane.

**Therefore
Let it be**

Enacted(1): In the interest of safety, that the Jones Street dumpster be moved to a location that does not impede pedestrian or vehicular traffic; and,


