#### The Exam Free November 18th Bill

"A bill requesting exams not to be scheduled on the anniversary of Bonfire."

- Whereas (1): The Texas A&M University Student Senate is the official voice of the student body; and,
- Whereas (2): Bonfire Memorial Service, in honor of the 12 Aggies who died on November 18<sup>th</sup> 1999, is held annually at 2:42 a.m.; and,
- Whereas (3): Attending this memorial service is an important tradition to the Aggie Family, and students should be free from the worry of exams following this tradition; and,
- Whereas (4): Exams held the morning after Bonfire Memorial may discourage students from attending this memorial service.

**Enacted (1):** That the Texas A&M University Student Senate request the University to institute an exam-free policy on November 18<sup>th</sup> of every year, should it fall on an academic day; and,
