The Simpson Drill Field Plagues Funding Request Bill

"A bill requesting for Senate to consider an allocation request to partially fund the replacement of the Simpson Drill Field plaques, based on the previous enaction of S.B. 66-32."

Whereas(1): S.B. 66-32 The Simpson Drill Field WWI Plaques Bill was passed by the 66th of

the Student Senate and sent to the Student Body President to enact; and,

Whereas(2): The Vice President of Student Services worked with the Corps Center and SSC to

find a funding solution; and,

Whereas(3): The Simpson Drill Field plaques and stands can be replaced for approximately

\$140 per plaques. However, the Student Government Association has been asked

to partially fund this initiative.

Therefore

Let it be

Enacted(1):

That the Student Senate authorizes an allocation for \$3850 to partially fund the

replacement of the plaques and stands for Simpson Drill Field provided that an unobtrusive plaque containing the wording "This plaque made possible by cooperation between Student Senate, Traditions Council, and SSC" or similar

wording be affixed to the plaque; and,

Enacted(2): That this legislation be presented to SSC, the Corps Center and the Executive

Branch upon its passage.
