Texas A&M Orchestra Bill

"A bill requesting that MUSC 283 be classified as an optional Visual and Performing Arts credit at Texas A&M University."

Whereas(1): The Texas A&M Orchestra is a one hour credit class (MUSC 283) offered to students as an elective credit ; and,

Whereas(2): Students taking MUSC 283 do not receive visual and performing arts credit; and,

Whereas(3): Several band classes participate in many of the same functions as MUSC 283 such as in-class rehearsals, mandatory out-of-class rehearsals, and put on concerts for the community and fellow Aggies while receiving visual and performing arts credit.

Enacted(1): That the Student Senate of Texas A&M University requests that MUSC 283 be included in the Core Curriculum as a possible visual and performing arts credit
