Student Billing Penalty Fee Bill

"A bill to request a change in the Student Business Services late fee policy."

Whereas(1): In accordance with Student Business Services policy, students who fail to pay fees and installments when due are assessed a \$25.00 late payment fee for each payment or installment paid late.

Whereas(2): There are multiple reasons why Student Business Services would refund a student after the standard refund date.

Whereas(3): Regardless of the amount owed to the University, if the payment is late, the student is automatically assessed the \$25.00 late payment fee per month.

Therefore

Enacted(1): That the Texas A&M University Student Government Association requests that Student Business Services review the late fee penalty policy for students with balances less than ten dollars.
