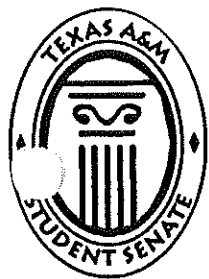

The West-Campus Garage Crosswalk Bill

"A bill to place crosswalks connecting the north entries of West Campus Garage with Lot 61."

- Whereas(1):** West Campus Garage serves to house approximately 3,705 parking permit holders; and,
- Whereas(2):** There is a large volume of pedestrian traffic that crosses John Kimbrough Blvd. between West Campus Garage and Lot 61 in order to cut travel time to their West Campus class locations (i.e. Kleberg, Heep, and Wehner); and,
- Whereas(3):** This has caused a safety hazard for students crossing John Kimbrough Blvd. due to the high amount of auto traffic funneling in and out of Wellborn Road, which is contiguous to John Kimbrough Blvd.
