The Spence-Lewis Safety Bill

"A bill requesting stop signs be placed at the intersection of Spence and Lewis."

Whereas(1): The Student Government Association serves as the voice of all students at Texas A&M University; and,

Whereas(2): "Stop for Pedestrians" signs exist between two-way Lewis Street intersecting Spence Street, causing confusion between pedestrians and drivers; and,

Whereas(3): Students have expressed concern in regards to the safety of walking across the intersection, especially at night; and,

Whereas(4): Parking lot 40-D in Southside campus, connected by the crosswalk at the intersection of Lewis Street and Spence Street, increases pedestrian traffic; and,

Whereas(5): Currently there are no crosswalk lights or stop signs between Lewis Street beginning from Bizzell Street and ending in Coke Street; and,

Whereas(6): Placing stop signs, giving pedestrians the safest option for right-of-way, will make the intersection safer for pedestrians and drivers.
