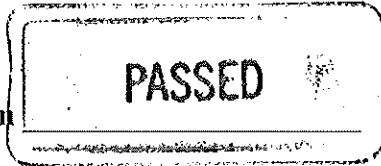

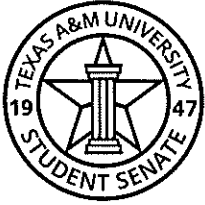

Enacted (1): It is required that all legislative authors submit to the Speaker pro tempore a compiled list of the recipients along with all formal titles and contact information for the sending of the bill upon passage of the legislation; and,

Enacted (2): Let there be an Article VI, Section V.I added to the Student Senate Bylaws which reads:

“For any legislation written such that a copy of the legislation is sent to an organization or individual that is outside of the Student Government Association, the legislative authors must compile a list of the recipients along with all formal titles and contact information, such as an email or mailing address, to the Speaker pro tempore. The Operations Committee will not send any legislation that does not comply with this regulation, or if the contact information is deemed inadequate or unprofessional by the Speaker pro tempore.”; and,

Enacted (3): The Operations Committee will store within the Senate Contact Records the submitted contact information for individuals and organizations that the Speaker pro tempore deems of merit for keeping; and,

Enacted (4): The codified positions of the Operations Committee are the Speaker pro tempore of the Senate, the Executive Director of Operations, the Director of the Cody T. Vasut Archives, the Director of Information Technology, the Director of Marketing, and the Director of Records. Any mention of further positions will be stricken from the SGAC, keeping with the codified precedent that the Speaker pro tempore can add more positions as they please; and,
