Whereas(2):

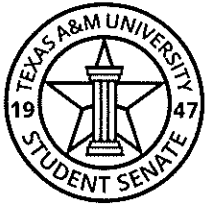
Since his time at Texas A&M, Congressman Flores has consistently reflected Texas A&M Core Values in all he has done; and,
