Weekend Library Hours Extension Bill

"A bill requesting the university to consider extending the weekend hours of the libraries."

Whereas(1): There are currently no campus library locations open later than 10 P.M. on Friday

and 9 P.M. on Saturday; and,

Whereas(2): Students seeking a quiet study area on campus on Friday and Saturday nights

must rely on buildings not always suitable for studying; and,

Whereas(3): Students who rely on University library computers and printers to complete

schoolwork are currently at the mercy of limited weekend operating hours.

Therefore

Let it be

That the Texas A&M Student Government Association recommends that the Enacted(1):

University Library Council keep at least one university library facility open 24

hours a day between Friday and Sunday; and,

Enacted(2): That the Texas A&M Student Government Association supports this move so

long as no additional student fees are required.
