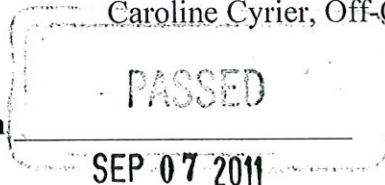

Big 12 Member Schools Accept Texas A&M's Departure to the SEC Resolution

"A resolution requesting that the Big 12 support Texas A&M's move to the SEC"

- Whereas(1):** Texas A&M University submitted a letter to the Big 12 stating intentions to leave the conference; and,
- Whereas(2):** On September 6, 2011 the member schools of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) voted unanimously to extend an invitation to Texas A&M on the condition that the member schools of the Big 12 make assurances that they would not pursue legal action; and,
- Whereas(3):** The Big 12 Commissioner, Dan Beebe, stated "it is in the best interests of each of our conferences and our member institutions of higher education to waive any and all legal actions" resulting from Texas A&M's departure.
