"A resolution congratulating Texas A&M University Vice Provost for Academic Affairs Dr. Pamela Matthews."

Whereas(1): On June 1, 2011, Provost and Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs Dr. Karan Watson appointed Dr. Pamela Matthews to the position of Vice Provost for Academic Affairs; and,

Whereas(2): In addition to serving as interim associate provost for undergraduate studies and associate provost for undergraduate studies, her administrative experience includes service as associate dean for undergraduate programs in the College of Liberal Arts, associate head of the Department of English, and director of Women's Studies (now Women's and Gender Studies), all at Texas A&M.; and,

Whereas(3): After completing a B.A. in English from the University of Houston and an M.A. in English at Texas A&M University, Dr. Matthews attended Duke University, where she received a Ph.D. in English with a specialization in American literature.
