The Freshmen Liberal Arts Reaching Excellence (FLARE) Appreciation Resolution

"A resolution expressing appreciation to the Freshmen Liberal Arts Reaching Excellence Freshmen Leadership Organization for their service to the College of Liberal Arts at Texas A&M University."

Whereas(1): FLARE (Freshmen in Liberal Arts Reaching Excellence) was founded in 2008 as an academic FLO (Freshman Leadership Organization) to provide freshman Liberal Arts majors the opportunity to develop both academically and socially within the Texas A&M College of Liberal Arts; and,
