"A bill requesting that the university allow students to transfer their unused printing allowance from the fall to the spring semester."

Whereas(1): Undergraduate and graduate students are given a print allowance of \$30 for each

fall and spring semester; and,

Whereas(2): This allocation may be used for black and white, color, transparencies and 11 x 17

printing; and,

Whereas(3): If a student prints out more than what is covered by the allocation they will be

billed for the excess printouts.
