Replacing Chopstix Bill

"A bill to replace the Chopstix restaurant with a concept that serves shakes/frozen-custard/ice-cream, similar to the "Shakes" frozen-custard restaurant chain."

Whereas(1): Texas A&M students do not respond favorably to the service and food served at the Chopstix restaurant located outside of the Commons; and,

Whereas(2): Texas A&M students were very disappointed when the "Shake's" frozen-custard restaurant closed down in College Station; and,

Whereas(3): In a student survey comprising of 292 responses, Texas A&M students showed tremendous support for replacing Chopstix with a concept that serves shakes/frozen-custard/ice-cream; similar to the "Shakes" frozen-custard restaurant chain; and,

Whereas(4): During conversations, Dining Services has expressed support and interest in moving forward with this concept.
