The Lot Ninety-Six (96) One Hour Parking Bill

"A bill to create two (2) one hour parking spaces in lot Ninety-Six (96)."

Whereas(1): Lot 96 was created to service the new Agriculture and Life Sciences Complex; and,

Whereas(2): It is located directly outside the AgriLife Center, an event center that is open to the public; and,

Whereas(3): All of the parking in Lot 96 is 24 hour reserved; and,

Whereas(4): There are many visitors to the AgriLife Center who don't have a place to park; and,

Whereas(5): There currently exists two spaces without lines where people have been parking who do not have a Lot 96 pass.

Therefore

Let it be

Enacted(1): The Texas A&M Student Senate, on behalf of the students of Texas A&M respectfully request that transportation services create two one hour parking spaces in Lot 96 (one to the right of reserved space 9647 and the other to the left of reserved space 9646); and,
