Minor in Legal Reasoning Creation Bill

"A bill requesting that Texas A&M University have a minor in legal reasoning to create a prelaw driven program for students."

Whereas(1): ~800 students each year graduate from Texas A&M University and pursue a career in the law; and,

Whereas(2): Currently, there is no pre-law program here at Texas A&M University; and,

Whereas(3): Law schools do not require a certain major or track to be accepted to law school, however, receiving education in law specific classes can be beneficial to students wishing to pursue a career in law; and,

Whereas(4): In comparison to pre-law based programs in other universities across Texas and The United States, Texas A&M University does have courses that are comparable to other pre-law programs which can be put into one degree or minor.
